* Accept the formula allocation of \$5,626,100 from the Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant program administered by the U.S. Department of Energy as part of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds that:

- 1. The purpose of the EECBG Program is to reduce fossil fuel emissions in a manner that is environmentally sustainable and maximizes the benefits for local and regional communities; to reduce the city's total energy use; and to improve the energy efficiency of the building sector, the transportation sector, and other appropriate sectors.
- 2. Funding from the EECBG Program will allow Portland to implement clean energy projects in municipal operations and programs to reduce energy use in homes, businesses, and transportation.
- 3. The U.S. Department of Energy has determined that Portland's formula allocation under the EECBG Program is \$5,626,100.
- 4. The EECBG Program does not require a City match.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The Mayor is authorized to accept the formula allocation of \$5,626,100 from the Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant (EECGB) program administered by the U.S. Department of Energy as part of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because postponing the acceptance of these grant funds will delay the economic and job creation benefits intended by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act; therefore this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
