ORDINANCE No. 183451

Apply for a grant from the State of Oregon Department of Environmental Quality for \$25,422 to support the recycling systems at Portland State University (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. In April 2006, the City of Portland Council passed Resolution No. 36423 establishing goals for the solid waste and recycling system, including a 75% recycling rate by 2015.
- 2. Portland City Code, Section 17.102.270 requires businesses to recycle 75% of their waste and this grant to SCRAP will help businesses meet that goal.
- 3. Portland State University (PSU) seeks to expand its sustainable practices through continuation of the current bin consolidation project of pairing trash with recycling stations. Highly visible material waste stations are being established in hallways, with all single trash cans removed. To improve the effectiveness of each station, two frames holding a total of four educational signs are needed at every station, one sign each for commingled recycling, glass recycling, trash and waste reduction/sustainability programs information. The funds will be used to purchase 1,134 frames for 567 stations, holding a total of 2,268 signs.
- 4. The Department of Environmental Quality provides grants to local jurisdictions around the State. By law, the grants must go to local governments, but local governments may contract with community groups, private individuals, non-profit organizations, schools, businesses or chambers of commerce to implement grant-funded projects.
- 5. The City's Solid Waste and Recycling program will pass this grant, if awarded, to PSU for this project.
- 6. No City match is required.

NOW, THEREFORE, the council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to make application to the Department of Environmental Quality for a grant in the amount of \$25,421.66.
- b. The Mayor is authorized to provide such information and assurances for the grant period.
