ORDINANCE No. 183452

Apply for a grant from the State of Oregon Department of Environmental Quality for \$30,250 to support Oregon Health and Sciences University Recycling Outreach (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. In April 2006, the City of Portland Council passed Resolution No. 36423 establishing goals for the solid waste and recycling system, including a 75% recycling rate by 2015.
- 2. Portland City Code, Section 17.102.270 requires businesses to recycle 75% of their waste and this grant to OHSU Recycling Outreach will help businesses meet that goal.
- 3. OHSU seeks to expand their sustainable practices to help educate employees, students and guests to create long term habits for recycling. Part of this program will include setting up a new office supply reuse program.
- 4. The Department of Environmental Quality provides grants to local jurisdictions around the State. By law, the grants must go to local governments, but local governments may contract with community groups, private individuals, non-profit organizations, schools, businesses or chambers of commerce to implement grant-funded projects.
- 5. The City's Solid Waste and Recycling program will pass this grant, if awarded, to OHSU for this project.
- 6. No City match is required.

NOW, THEREFORE, the council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to make application to the Department of Environmental Quality for a grant in the amount of \$30,250.00.
- b. The Mayor is authorized to provide such information and assurances for the grant period.
