ORDINANCE No. 183456

*Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Tri-County Metropolitan Transportation District of Oregon for support services related to construction of the Portland Streetcar Loop Project (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The City currently is constructing the Portland Streetcar Loop Project, which will extend Streetcar service across the Broadway Bridge and south to the Oregon Museum of Science and Industry (Project).
- 2. The City desires support services and other expertise from the Tri-County Metropolitan Transportation District of Oregon (TriMet) on various matters related to construction of the Project and in compliance with Federal Transit Administration rules and regulations.
- 3. Desired services include right-of-way acquisition; quality assurance/quality control; DBE program management; coordinating vehicle testing; start-up activities; operations planning and revenue service; program management; grants management and processing, before and after study; and assignment of outside Project Management Oversight as needed.
- 4. The City and TriMet have agreed to a scope and budget for the services, with needed resources within the overall Project budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and the City Auditor are hereby authorized to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with TriMet, substantially in accordance with the Intergovernmental Agreement attached to the original of this Ordinance and, by reference, made a part hereof.
- b. The Mayor and the City Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver checks payable to TriMet, chargeable to the Transportation Operating Fund, Fund 200000, Business Area TR00.
- c. The City's Project Manager is hereby authorized to agree to and execute, on behalf of the City, any amendment that does not increase the compensation amount.

Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists because the main construction activities for the Project will commence on January 4, 2010; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
