

ORDINANCE No. 183462

Authorize the renewal of an Individual Site License Agreement with LCW Wireless, LLC for use of a portion of the Children's Museum in Washington Park for wireless communication purposes. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. LCW Wireless, LLC, dba Cricket Communications (Cricket), is a wireless communications company licensed by the Federal Communications Commission to operate in the State of Oregon.
2. The Children's Museum in Washington Park has been assigned to Portland Parks & Recreation (Parks).
3. In 2006, Parks entered into a Master License Agreement, Contract No 52766, with Cricket pursuant to Ordinance 180560 that contains the terms and conditions under which Cricket locates and operates cell sites on Parks property.
4. Pursuant to Ordinance 180561, Cricket entered into an Individual Site License for the installation, maintenance and operation of antennas and other equipment at the Children's Museum.
5. The Individual Site License expired on December 12, 2009 and Cricket's option to renew was not exercised within the prescribed timeframe, thus invalidating the option. Nevertheless, both parties wish to renew the agreement, so Parks recommends accepting the late notice of intent to renew.
6. The renewal term will be for three years and annual rent will be \$38,768.06, increased by 2.5% annually.

NOW, THEREFORE, The Council Directs:


- a. The Director of Parks is authorized to accept Cricket's late notice of intent to renew and to automatically renew the Individual License Agreement on the same terms and conditions, except that the rent for the first year of the renewal term will be \$38,768.06 per year.
