Authorize a contract and provide payment for construction of the Umatilla Pump Station Upgrade Project No. E08589 (Ordinance).

### The City of Portland ordains:

#### Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) has a need to remodel the existing Umatilla Pump Station.
- 2. The upgrade of the Umatilla Pump Station has been identified as a priority project within the BES Pump Station Improvement Program.
- 3. The established construction cost is \$910,000. The level of confidence in the estimated construction cost is Optimal. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2010 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, WBS Element E08589.C14.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the council directs:

- a. The Commissioner of Public Affairs and Auditor are authorized to execute a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for the purpose described in Section 1.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
