Replace Exhibit A of Ordinance No. 182841 relating to sewer and drainage rates and charges for FY 2009-2010 (Ordinance; amend Ordinance No. 182841)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. On April 2, 2008, Council adopted Ordinance No. 181714 establishing sanitary sewer conversion charges to recover City costs to replace non-conforming sanitary sewer connections with individual and direct private sanitary sewer connections.
- 2. The Council intended to incorporate sanitary sewer conversion charges in the annual rate schedule for sewer and drainage rates and charges beginning with the schedule for Fiscal Year 2009-2010.
- 3. Ordinance No. 182841, adopted May 27, 2009, authorized sewer and drainage rates and charges for Fiscal Year 2009-2010 without incorporating the sanitary sewer conversion charges authorized by Ordinance No. 181714.
- 4. This Ordinance corrects this omission by amending Exhibit A of Ordinance No. 182841 to include the following highlighted text:
 - D. Sewage System Development Charges

 (authorized by <u>Ordinance No. 181714, and</u> City Code Sections 17.32.015, 17.36.020 and 17.36.025; formerly specified in Title 17, Figure 5)

3. <u>Sanitary Sewer Conversion Charges</u> a. <u>Simple Sewer Extensions</u> \$1.83 per square foot b. Complex Sewer Extensions \$4.08 per square foot

NOW, THEREFORE, the council directs:

- a. Exhibit A of Ordinance No. 182841 is replaced by Exhibit A of this ordinance.
- b. This ordinance and exhibit are binding City policy.


