

**ORDINANCE No. 183557**

\*Accept a \$400,000 grant from the U. S. Department of Energy Recovery Act- Solar Market Transformation: Solar America Cities Special Projects to promote market expansion of solar within Portland and select communities in Oregon (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

**Section 1. The Council finds**

1. Bureau of Planning and Sustainability applied to the United States Department of Energy for a grant in the amount of \$400,000 for The Neighborhood Solar Initiative on July 30, 2009; and
2. The United States Department of Energy has notified the City of Portland that it will award a grant for The Neighborhood Solar Initiative to the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability in the amount of \$400,000; and
3. Since 1990, with the passage of Ordinance 162975, the City has had a stated policy to “support environmentally acceptable, sustainable energy sources, especially renewable resources such as solar;” and
4. The City’s Bureau of Planning and Sustainability will administer this grant in order to implement the project; and
5. Local match in the amount of \$231,379 will be provided by funds in the form of salary, benefits, and materials and services in the FY 2009-10 and FY 2010-11 budgets of the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability. Additional match in the amount of \$202,218 will come from several private sources.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from the United States Department of Energy for The Neighborhood Solar Initiative in the amount of \$400,000.
- b. The FY 2009/2010 budget is hereby amended as follows:

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
