

**ORDINANCE No. 183640**

\* Ratify a Letter of Agreement between the City and Portland Police Association to authorize the inclusion of time worked at Multnomah County Sheriff's Office for longevity computation (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The City and the Portland Police Association have a mutual interest in seeing the City hire and retain able and experienced police officers.
2. Pursuant to that goal, the City engaged in a specialized lateral recruitment of Multnomah County Deputies (Recruitment #07-151).
3. In furtherance of that recruitment, both the City and the Portland Police Association agreed that length of employment at Multnomah County Sheriff's Office should be included in length of employment for purposes of longevity computation for the officers hired pursuant to Recruitment #07-151.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That the Letter of Agreement between the City and the Portland Police Association attached as Exhibit A is hereby ratified by the Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order that this compensation action may occur without delay; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from after its passage by the Council.


