

ORDINANCE No. 183692

*Authorize Intergovernmental Agreement with Multnomah County to provide and receive funds to and from Department of School & Community Partnerships for the SUN Community Schools initiative (Ordinance).

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Education is the primary responsibility of the schools, and extended-day programs provide new opportunities to motivate, enrich and support student learning.
2. Many considerations affect the quality of young people's education, including social, health and emotional concerns. Comprehensive models address these concerns.
3. Bridges between the extended program and the regular school curriculum can help raise academic achievement. The extended learning school curriculum should be challenging, fun and reflect diverse strengths and interests.
4. Involving families as decision-makers, volunteers, and participants in activities with their children and other adults is vital to success.
5. All community members should have the opportunity to play a role in the community schools model.
6. Youth should be involved as resources in the provision of change versus being seen as the objects of the planning of change.
7. Public sites should be made more accessible for community utilization.
8. SUN Community Schools embraces the principle of involving and working together with everybody in the community, a goal shared by the City of Portland and Multnomah County.
9. SUN Community Schools is the central element in the County's SUN Service System of youth and family development
10. Priority goals for the City include making "a family friendly city" and supporting public school districts.
11. Portland Parks & Recreation wishes to continue their partnership with Multnomah County and the SUN Schools program by providing funding in the amount of \$285,094 for FY 2009-10.

12. Multnomah County will reimburse Portland Parks & Recreation for Inclusion Services provided at SUN community school sites not staffed by City coordinators.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That the Mayor and Auditor are authorized to execute an agreement on behalf of the City with Multnomah County, substantially in the form of the Agreement attached to this Ordinance, for the collaborative operations of SUN Community Schools.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to avoid further delay in the payment of these funds before the end of the fiscal year; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
