ORDINANCE No. 183725

* Amend the City of Portland Health Plan to reflect necessary plan administrative and design changes as recommended by the Labor Management Benefits Committee for self-insured plans beginning July 1, 2010. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Office of Management and Finance, Bureau of Human Resources requires the continuing provision of employee health and welfare administration.
- 2. The Office of Management and Finance, Bureau of Human Resources has worked collaboratively with the Labor Management Benefits Committee to provide employees with enhanced preventive care, routine office visit accessessibility and chronic disease management benefits in support of the City's Wellness Strategic Plan as modified within the City of Portland Health Plan.
- 3. In order to maintain employee health and welfare benefits on behalf of employees, retirees, COBRA participants and their eligible dependents, it is deemed appropriate and necessary to approve the 2010-2011 City of Portland Health Plan effective July 1, 2010 as attached in the following Exhibit A.

The Health Fund Budgets for FY 2010-11 include appropriations in support of the plan design reflected within the City of Portland Health Plan.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The Mayor or the Director of Human Resources is hereby authorized to execute plan document amendments during the plan year as required by any applicable law during the term of the contract, substantially similar hereto as Exhibit A attached.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to avoid undue and costly delay in providing benefits to plan participants; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
