ORDINANCE No. 183816

*Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with Multnomah Department of Human Services' Area Agency on Aging to support specialized urban and human services to the elderly for the period July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2014 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. There are well over 100,000 persons over the age of 60 in the City and the County, and the problems of those elderly persons with fixed incomes and frail health demand demonstrated support for services to this population.
- 2. The Multnomah County Area Agency on Aging (AAA) has as a critical responsibility to plan, coordinate and conduct a comprehensive social service delivery system for elderly residents within the boundaries of Multnomah County and the City of Portland, since 1984. The City and the County are both committed through the Aging Policy for Portland and Multnomah County of 1982 to support specialized urban and human services to the elderly and to jointly fund the AAA in its efforts toward funding senior district service centers.
- 3. Contract #32024 (County Contract #400329) was originally entered into on July 1, 1998, with Multnomah County to provide support for the AAA, and authorized by Ordinance #172794. This long standing Agreement requires updating annually to specify budget appropriation.
- 4. This Agreement provides funds in the amount of \$594,959 to Multnomah County for the period July 1, 2009, through June 30, 2010, for support of the Area Agency on Aging for Portland/Multnomah County. The funds shall continue to be used for District Senior Center related services and senior center development.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. That the Mayor and the Auditor are authorized to execute this Agreement on behalf of the City, substantially in the form of the Agreement attached to this Ordinance, with Multnomah County for the joint funding of AAA.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to avoid further delay in the payment of these funds before the end of the fiscal year; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
