ORDINANCE No. 183854

Authorize \$1,462,068 for grant agreements divided between five neighborhood District Coalitions to support civic participation services for neighborhood associations and individuals within their target areas from July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2015. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The five neighborhood District Coalitions are critical partners working with ONI to implement *The Five-Year Plan to Strengthen Community Involvement in Portland*, (adopted by City Council on February 27, 2008), which includes concrete actions steps organized around three interdependent goals:
 - Increase the number and diversity of people involved in their communities
 - Strengthen community capacity
 - Increase community impact on public decisions
- 2. This grant agreement provides financial and limited staff assistance resources from the City of Portland Office of Neighborhood Involvement (ONI) to these five recognized District Coalitions per City Code 3.96.010 to provide such services by which the people of the City of Portland may effectively participate in civic affairs and work to improve the livability and character of their Neighborhoods and the City.
- 3. This grant agreement shall also comply with City policy ADM-4.03 Standards for Neighborhood Associations, District Coalitions, Business District Associations, and the Office of Neighborhood Involvement.
- 4. The term of this grant is five years, with an option to extend for an additional five years.
- 5. A total of \$1,462,068 in General Fund dollars is allocated in the Office of Neighborhood Involvement FY 2010-11 adopted budget for distributing these grants as part of the Neighborhood Program.
- 6. Grant funds should be allocated to the Grantees in the future for the term of this grant without the need for an additional ordinance authorizing this expenditure, provided funds for this purpose are allocated in a City budget adopted by City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The Director of the Office of Neighborhood Involvement and the City Auditor are authorized to execute grant agreements on behalf of the City to the five neighborhood District Coalitions in a form substantially in accordance with Exhibits A(1), A(2), A(3), A(4), A(5) in the amounts below:

- b. The Director of the Office of Neighborhood Involvement is authorized to draw and deliver warrants in accordance with the grants shown in Exhibits A(1), A(2), A(3), A(4), A(5).
- c. The Office of Neighborhood Involvement is authorized to issue grants to the five neighborhood District Coalitions to support civic participation services for neighborhood associations and individuals within their target areas in the City of Portland in the amount of \$1,401.425 in FY 2010-11 with future year funding based on the adopted budget for that year.
- d. Amendments to the grant agreements may be agreed to and executive by the Director of the Office of Neighborhood Involvement or her/his designee.
