## **ORDINANCE No.** 183867

\*Authorize five grants for the Workforce Training & Hiring Program to local non-profits in an amount not to exceed \$10,000 per grant (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The City of Portland (City) Workforce Training & Hiring Program is charged with providing and maximizing apprenticeship and employment opportunities for minorities and women workers in the construction trades.
- 2. The City collects funds through the City's compliance-related activities and distributes grants to community non-profits that provide apprenticeship opportunities and technical assistance to further the City's efforts.
- 3. The Bureau of Internal Business Services Procurement Services Division, formerly known as Bureau of Purchases, has solicited and received grant proposals from community non-profits to provide apprenticeship opportunities and technical assistance. These community non-profits are Oregon Tradeswomen, Inc., Irvington Covenant Community Development Corporation, Straight Path, Inc., Portland Community College Evening Trades Apprenticeship Preparation Program, and Portland Youthbuilders.
- 4. The Procurement Services Division has reviewed and recommended the issuance of grant funds to support the activities of these community non-profits.
- 5. The Procurement Services Division has the funds for these grants in its FY09/10 budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Chief Procurement Officer (CPO) to execute the grant agreements to Oregon Tradeswomen, Inc., Irvington Covenant Community Development Corporation, Straight Path, Inc., and Portland Community College - Evening Trades Apprenticeship Preparation Program in the amount of \$10,000 each and a grant to Portland Youthbuilders, in the amount of \$9,700, for the purposes identified in Section 1.
- b. The CPO and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver check(s) payable to Oregon Tradeswomen, Inc., Irvington Covenant Community Development Corporation, Straight Path, Inc., Portland Community College - Evening Trades Apprenticeship Preparation Program and Portland Youthbuilders, chargeable to the appropriate authorization and accounting center when demand is presented and approved by the proper authorities.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because any delay in providing grant funding to the grant recipients would delay program implementation and would harm the public interest; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
