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**ORDINANCE No. 183881**

\*Authorize Bureau of Purchases to enter into a contract and provide for payment for construction of the Road Rehabilitation – 2010, SE Clinton Street Project (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Pavement conditions on SE Clinton Street between SE 26<sup>th</sup> Avenue and SE 50<sup>th</sup> Avenue, have deteriorated to a point where they have been prioritized for significant preventative maintenance and rehabilitation.
2. SE Clinton Street is a highly used neighborhood collector street and bike boulevard that carries over 2,000 bike trips per day.
3. The Bureau of Transportation has prepared plans, specifications and an estimate for the preventative maintenance and rehabilitation of this roadway.
4. Funds to construct, inspect, and manage this preservation project are available in the FY 2009-10 budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Purchasing Agent is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office.
- b. The Commissioner-in-Charge is authorized to sign a contract, approved as to form by the City Attorney's office, with the lowest responsive and responsible bidder as determined by the Purchasing Agent.
- c. The Auditor to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to T00235.C35 when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in executing this Ordinance will delay award of the project affecting the project completion, and not encumber funds budgeted in the current FY; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
