ORDINANCE No. 183881

*Authorize Bureau of Purchases to enter into a contract and provide for payment for construction of the Road Rehabilitation – 2010, SE Clinton Street Project (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Pavement conditions on SE Clinton Street between SE 26th Avenue and SE 50th Avenue, have deteriorated to a point where they have been prioritized for significant preventative maintenance and rehabilitation.
- 2. SE Clinton Street is a highly used neighborhood collector street and bike boulevard that carries over 2,000 bike trips per day.
- 3. The Bureau of Transportation has prepared plans, specifications and an estimate for the preventative maintenance and rehabilitation of this roadway.
- 4. Funds to construct, inspect, and manage this preservation project are available in the FY 2009-10 budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Purchasing Agent is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office.
- b. The Commissioner-in-Charge is authorized to sign a contract, approved as to form by the City Attorney's office, with the lowest responsive and responsible bidder as determined by the Purchasing Agent.
- c. The Auditor to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to T00235.C35 when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in executing this Ordinance will delay award of the project affecting the project completion, and not encumber funds budgeted in the current FY; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
