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ORDINANCE No. 183891

*Amend Intergovernmental Agreement with Oregon Department of Transportation to insert new terms of agreement requirements for electrical inspectors (Ordinance, amend Contract No. 30000940)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The City of Portland (City) and Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) entered into IGA No. 25,404 via Ordinance No. 183068, dated August 5, 2009, to accept a grant that provided funding for installation of an adaptive signal system along US 26 from SE Milwaukie to 52nd Avenue.
2. Preliminary engineering, construction, and implementation costs are funded with a \$1,639,677 grant from ODOT.
3. The City and ODOT has determined that Paragraph 17 of the IGA shall be amended to read as follows:
"17. Agency, or its contractor's, electrical inspectors shall possess a current State Certified Traffic Signal Inspector certificate, in order to inspect electrical installations on State highways. The State District Permitting Office shall verify compliance with this requirement prior to construction. The permit fee should also cover the electrical supplemental inspection."

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That the Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to execute an amendment to Contract No. 30000940, substantially in accordance with the agreement attached to the original of this Ordinance and, by reference, made a part hereof.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would negatively impact the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.


