

# ORDINANCE No. 183906

Authorize Intergovernmental Agreement with the Oregon Department of Environmental Quality for laboratory services for Senate Bill 737 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Oregon Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) has issued Orders to 52 municipalities including the City, Order No. WQ/M-NWR-10-120 (Order) to screen wastewater effluent from Columbia Blvd and Tryon Creek wastewater treatment plants for 117 priority pollutants twice in 2010.
2. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES), Water Pollution Control Laboratory (WPCL) does not have the proper instrumentation and/or expertise to do these analyses. DEQ has acquired the instrumentation and capabilities to provide these analytical services to the City and the other municipalities.
3. DEQ will provide the laboratory services to the municipalities through an intergovernmental agreement (IGA) to fulfill the regulatory requirement of Order. Failure to provide such services may expose the City to stipulated penalties under the terms of the Order.
4. The established cost for the laboratory services provided is not to exceed \$27,900 for the one year term of the IGA. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2010-2011 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, WBS Number ESPP000015, Account Number 521000.


NOW, THEREFORE, the council directs:

- a. The Director of the Bureau of Environmental Services is authorized to execute an Intergovernmental Agreement with DEQ, similar to Attachment A, for the purpose described in Section 1, in the amount of \$27,900.00.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
