# ORDINANCE NO. 183941

Amend Intergovernmental Agreement with Multnomah County for the Water/Sewer Bill Discount and Crisis Assistance Program (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 38119)

## The City of Portland ordains:

#### Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The City has an interest in providing financial assistance to eligible low income households who cannot afford water and sewer utility payments.
- 2. The City has a need to continue to acquire program administration services for the Water/Sewer Bill Discount and Crisis Assistance Program.
- 3. The City desires to amend the existing Intergovernmental Agreement with Multnomah County to provide administration of eligibility verification for the Water/Sewer Bill Discount and Crisis Assistance Program.
- 4. The Intergovernmental Agreement shall be amended to increase the budget by \$180,000. The new agreement total will be \$360,000.
- 5. Funding of \$90,000 is budgeted in the Low-Income Assistance Program to cover administration of eligibility which is available in the FY 2010-11 Budget and additional funding will be requested in the FY 2011-12 Budget.

### NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That the Commissioner-in-Charge and Auditor are authorized to execute on behalf of the City the amendment to the Intergovernmental Agreement with Multnomah County to continue to provide administration of eligibility verification for the Water/Sewer Bill Discount and Crisis Assistance Program attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The Auditor is hereby authorized to draw and deliver checks payable to Multnomah County, when demand is presented and approved by the proper authorities, chargeable to internal order 9WACS0000336.

c. Amendments increasing the total compensation to the Intergovernmental Agreement may be agreed to and executed by the Water Bureau Administrator. Any increase exceeding twenty-five percent of the total compensation would need City Council approval.
