

ORDINANCE No. 183948

* Ratify a Letter of Agreement with AFSCME Local 189 authorizing reimbursement of an additional pair of safety shoes for employees in the Water Meter Reader I and II classifications at the Water Bureau. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Employees in the Water Meter Reader I and II classifications at the Water Bureau work in a variety of conditions and terrain, including opening manhole gates.
2. Due to the amount of exposure to harsh conditions and terrain, the annual clothing allowance provided in Article 29.2 of the Labor Agreement between the City of Portland (City) and the District Council of Trades Unions is not sufficient for these employees to maintain adequate footwear and rain gear.
3. The City and ASFCME Local 189 have a mutual interest in ensuring that Water Meter Readers maintain adequate footwear and rain gear.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Letter of Agreement between the City and AFSCME Local 189 attached as Exhibit A is hereby ratified by the Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order that this compensation action may occur without delay; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from after its passage by the Council.


