ORDINANCE No. 184026

*Authorize subrecipient contract with Portland Development Commission totaling \$5,044,954 for the coordination of the Economic Opportunity Initiative Programs and provide for payment. (Ordinance; Contract No. 32000393)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Portland Development Commission (PDC) is charged by the City Charter with implementing the vision and goals of the City of Portland relating to economic development as adopted by the City Council.
- 2. The City's Portland Housing Bureau (PHB) developed a strategic plan, and in 2004 began implementing the Economic Opportunity Initiative, designed to reduce poverty citywide.
- 3. The purpose of the Economic Opportunity Initiative is to help propel low-income people out of poverty through participation in two program elements: a three-year program of youth and adult workforce development, providing occupational training, job placement, case management, support services, career advancement and peer coaching; and a three-year microenterprise development program which offers business education, technical training, planning assistance, life skills and peer support.
- 4. The Economic Opportunity Initiative is a national model for developing and implementing best practices workforce and microenterprise development for multi-barriered, very low income populations.
- 5. By funding the Economic Opportunity Initiative programs with PDC's ongoing economic development activities, the City enhances its ability to deliver community-wide economic development assistance.
- 6. To accomplish this objective, the Council desires to enter into a contract with PDC in the amount not to exceed \$5,044,954 in FY 2010-11, of which \$1,399,644 comes from Office of Management and Finance's (OMF) General Fund, \$3,195,310 comes from PHB's CDBG-Formula fund, and \$450,000 comes from PHB's CDBG-ARRA fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Bureau Director and City Auditor are authorized to execute and amend Contract No. 32000393 with PDC in a form substantially similar to the attached Exhibit A.
- b. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to make payment chargeable to the FY 2010-11 PHB's and OMF's operating fund budgets when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay in funding would interrupt PDC's ability to coordinate the Economic Opportunity Initiative Programs; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.


