ORDINANCE No. 184064

*Authorize a collaborative partnership agreement with Oregon Occupational Safety and Health Administration to encourage and promote expanded involvement of City bureaus in the Safety and Health Achievement Recognition Program (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Office of Management and Finance, Bureau of Internal Business Services has qualified Senior Risk Specialists on staff capable of assisting City bureaus through the application process to achieve and maintain certification with Oregon Occupational Safety and Health Administration's (OR OSHA) Safety and Health Achievement Recognition Program (SHARP).
- 2. OR OSHA has limited staff available to assist city bureaus through the SHARP application process.
- 3. The establishment of a collaborative partnership, substantially in conformance with Exhibit A attached, is in the best interest of the City to accomplish these tasks within the time required.
- 4. A collaborative partnership agreement improves City bureaus' access to resources and services needed to achieve certification in a timely and flexible manner.
- 5. The Partnership Agreement will be a term of five (5) years and end on August 10, 2015.
- 6. There are no costs involved in establishing this Partnership Agreement.
- 7. The City of Portland previously had a 2-year partnership agreement with Oregon Occupational Safety and Health Administration, ending in 2008, to encourage and assist city bureaus in attaining certification in OR OSHA's Safety & Health Achievement Recognition Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a) The City Risk Manager is authorized to execute the Partnership Agreement with OR OSHA substantially in conformance with Exhibit A, attached.

Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists because a City bureau intends to pursue SHARP certification; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
