

## Ordinance No. 184072

\* Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with Portland Public Schools and TriMet to continue the Student Transit Pass Project to offer fareless public transportation for high-school students at Portland Public Schools (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. On June 11, 2008, Council unanimously approved Resolution #36611 expressing support for a proposal by the Multnomah Youth Commission to create a "Youth Pass Program" allowing fareless access to public transportation for students.
2. On September 3, 2008, Council unanimously approved Ordinance #182165 directing the Mayor and the Commissioner of Public Utilities to enter into a contract with TriMet and Portland Public Schools for the Student Transit Pass Pilot Project to offer free transit passes to students at two Portland high schools.
3. On December 24, 2008, Council unanimously approved Ordinance #\_182445 as Amended directing the Mayor and the Commissioner of Public Utilities to enter into a contract with TriMet and Portland Public Schools expanding the Pilot Project to offer free transit passes to students at three Portland high schools.
4. On August 26, 2009, Council unanimously approved Ordinance #\_183144 directing the Mayor and the Auditor to enter into a contract with TriMet and Portland Public Schools to expand the Transit Pass Project to offer fareless public transportation to all Portland Public Schools high-school students.
5. The City, TriMet and Portland Public Schools now wish to renew their formal agreement regarding the roles and responsibilities of each party for the continuation of the "Student Transit Pass Project," or as it is commonly known, "YouthPass."

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL DIRECTS


- a. The Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with TriMet and Portland Public Schools in a form substantially in accordance with the intergovernmental agreement attached as Exhibit A.

- b. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for said agreement from general funds.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because students are to receive passes effective on September 1, 2010; therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
