* Accept and appropriate a \$155,445 grant from the U.S. Department of Justice Office of Justice Programs for the FY2010 Paul Coverdell Forensic Science Improvement Grants Program for digital evidence photo processing (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds

- 1. The Police Bureau applied to the U.S. Department of Justice Office of Justice Programs for a grant in the amount of \$155,445 for the FY2010 Paul Coverdell Forensic Science Improvement Grants Program on May 10, 2010.
- 2. The Office of Justice Programs has notified the City that it will award a grant for the FY2010 Paul Coverdell Forensic Science Improvement Grant to the Police Bureau in the amount of \$155,445.
- 3. The Paul Coverdell Forensic Science Improvement Grant will allow the Bureau's Forensic Evidence Division to move to a fully digital format in its evidence photo processing. The move will allow for faster turn-around time for processing photographic evidence and make images available to stakeholders more quickly and in a variety of digital formats.
- 4. The grant has a non-federal match component of \$94,500 which will be funded by donations of computer equipment from Intel Corporation and digital information management solution software from Linear Systems.
- 5. The grant award period is from October 1, 2010 to September 30, 2011.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from the U.S. Department of Justice Office of Justice Programs in the amount of \$155,445.
- b. The FY 2010/2011 budget is hereby amended as follows:

Bureau Program Expenses - \$115,445

c. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
