* Authorize application to the Department of Housing and Urban Development for a grant in the amount of \$1,000,000 to identify and correct housing-related health and safety hazards in low-income housing. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1 the Council finds that:

- 1. The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development has made available a Notice of Financial Assistance for Healthy Homes Repairs. These funds are available to protect children and the elderly from housing-related environmental health and safety hazards in situations where housing conditions may contribute to illness, injury, or adverse health outcomes.
- 2. The Portland Housing Bureau is responding to the Notice of Financial Assistance with an application for \$1,000,000 in federal funds.
- 3. The grant application does not require matching resources.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- A. The Mayor is hereby authorized to make application to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for a grant in the amount of \$1,000,000.
- B. The Mayor is authorized to provide such information and assurances as are required for the grant period.
- C. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists since the application must be submitted to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development in Washington, D.C. no later than November 8, 2010; therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
