## ORDINANCE No. 184255

\* Accept a grant in the amount of \$479,068 and appropriate \$180,000 for FY 2011 from the U.S.Department of Justice, Office of Community Oriented Policing Services FY 2010 Child Sexual Predator Program (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Police Bureau applied to the United States Department of Justice (USDOJ), Office of Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS), FY 2010 Child Sexual Predator Program (CSPP) for a grant in the amount of \$479,068 for funding to establish and/or enhance strategies to locate, arrest and prosecute child sexual predators and exploiters, as well as enforce state sex offender registration laws.
- 2. The United States Department of Justice has notified the City of Portland that it will award a grant in order to enhance the work of the Bureau's Sex Offender Registration Detail, which includes ensuring victim and community safety through effective enforcement, management and supervision of child sexual predators.
- 3. The USDOJ will reimburse the City for sworn and non-sworn personnel overtime, specialized training and program supplies not to exceed the awarded amount of \$479,048.
- 4. The grant period is September 1, 2010 through August 31, 2012. No match is required for this grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Community Oriented Policing Services FY 2010 Child Sexual Predator Program in the amount of \$479,068.
- b. The FY 2010/2011 budget is hereby amended as follows: <u>GRANTS FUND</u> Fund - 217 Business Area – PL00 Bureau Program Expenses - \$180,000

PROVIDER FUND Fund - 706 Business Area - MF06 Bureau Program Expenses - \$335

- c. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.
- d. The Chief of the Police Bureau of the City of Portland is authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland any subsequent modifications to the U.S. Department of Justice for the FY 2010 Child Sexual Predator Program, #2010-CS-WX-0004, provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant; therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
