ORDINANCE No. 184283

* Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Oregon Department of Transportation for the Right-of-Way Services Agreement for the Safe Routes to School Program that includes bicycle and pedestrian safety improvements at eight Portland public elementary schools. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds

- 1. On July 25, 2007, Council approved Ordinance No. 181167 that authorized the Portland Bureau of Transportation to submit two applicants to receive grant funding through Safer Routes to School Program, administered by the Oregon Department of Transportation.
- 2. On January 19, 2010, the Oregon Department of Transportation awarded the Portland Bureau of Transportation a Safer Routes to School grant to fund bicycle and pedestrian safety improvements at eight Portland public elementary schools.
- 3. On October 20, 2010, Council approved Ordinance No. 184168 that authorized a grant funding that covered the total anticipated cost for engineering and construction of the project, estimated at approximately \$495,000. This Intergovernmental Agreement is only to do the right-of-way acquisitions (in our case only temporary easements).
- 4. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimates for this project is low, because the project has not yet been engineered.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The Mayor is hereby is hereby authorized to execute an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Oregon Department of Transportation for Right-of-Way Services for the Safe Routes to School Program that includes bicycle and pedestrian safety improvements at eight Portland public elementary schools, in substantially the form of the attached exhibit for this purpose.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
