* Accept a grant in the amount of \$50,000 and appropriate \$40,000 for FY 2011 from the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance FY 2010 Gang Resistance Education and Training Program - Evaluation Sites Local program for program expenses (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Police Bureau applied to the United States Department of Justice (USDOJ), Office of Justice Programs (OJP), Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA) FY 2010 Gang Resistance Education and Training Program Evaluation Sites (Local) program for a grant in the amount of \$50,000 for funding that will aid in the delivery of the Elementary and Middle School curriculums as well as the G.R.E.A.T. Families and Summer Components on July 22, 2010.
- 2. The United States Department of Justice has notified the City of Portland that it will award a grant for the G.R.E.A.T. Local program to the Police Bureau in the amount of \$50,000.
- 3. The USDOJ will reimburse the City for program expenses, which include officer instruction overtime, staff travel, supplies and intra-agency expenses not to exceed the awarded amount of \$50,000. The grant period is October 1, 2010, through September 30, 2011.
- 4. Local match in the amount of \$207,365 will be provided by funds from FY 2010/11 and FY 2011/12 Police Bureau program budget appropriations.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance for the FY 2010 Gang Resistance Education and Training Program Evaluation Sites (Local) program in the amount of \$50,000.
- b. The FY 2010/2011 budget is hereby amended as follows:

GRANTS FUND

Fund - 217 Business Area – PL00 Bureau Program Expenses - \$40,000

PROVIDER FUND

Fund - 706 Business Area - MF06 Bureau Program Expenses - \$909

PROVIDER FUND

Fund - 702 Business Area - MF02 Bureau Program Expenses - \$2,375

- c. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.
- d. The Chief of the Police Bureau of the City of Portland is authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland any subsequent modifications to the U.S. Department of Justice for the FY 2010 Gang Resistance Education and Training Program - Evaluation Sites (Local) program, #2010-JV-FX-0010, provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
