ORDINANCE No. 1 8 4 2 9 9

* Accept and appropriate a grant in the amount of \$198,290 from U.S. Department of Homeland Security for FY 2009 Buffer Zone Plan and Vulnerability Reduction Purchase Plan (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds

1. The United States Department of Homeland Security, Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), Grant Programs Directorate (GPD), and the Office of Infrastructure Protection (IP), Protective Security Coordination Division (PSCD) awarded a FY 2009 Buffer Zone Plan and Vulnerability Reduction Purchase Plan (BZPP) grant in the amount of \$198,290 to the State of Oregon- Portland Water Bureau, Portland Police Bureau on August 10, 2010; and

2. The United States Department of Homeland Security has notified the City that it awarded a grant for the immediate purchase of terrorism prevention and intervention capital equipment to be installed at the Portland Water Bureau sites to the Police Bureau in the amount of \$198,290;

3. Per Department of Homeland Security requirements, the BZPP Program grant project information is exempt from public information disclosure laws under ORS 192.501, sections 18, 22, 23 and ORS 192.502, section 32.

4. The grant period is November 15, 2010, through December 31, 2011.

5. This grant does not require matching funds.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from the United States Department of Homeland Security, Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), Grant Programs Directorate (GPD), and the Office of Infrastructure Protection (IP), Protective Security Coordination Division (PSCD) for the purchase of terrorism prevention and intervention capital equipment to be installed at the Portland Water Bureau sites to the Police Bureau in the amount of \$198,290.
- b. The FY 2010/2011 budget is hereby amended as follows:

<u>GRANTS FUND</u> Fund 217 Business Area – PL00 Bureau Program Expenses– \$198,290

- c. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.
- d. The Chief of the Police Bureau of the City of Portland is authorized to accept on behalf of the City any subsequent modifications by The United States Department of Homeland Security, Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), Grant Programs Directorate (GPD), and the Office of Infrastructure Protection (IP), Protective Security Coordination Division (PSCD) for FY 2009 Buffer Zone Plan Portland Water Bureau grant, 09-091, provided such modifications do not increase the City's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.


