ORDINANCE No. 1843 11

*Authorize a Price Agreement with Pacific Rock Products, LLC, dba CEMEX, to provide Bulk Mixed Concrete for a 5-year contractual total not to exceed \$2,850,000. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Portland Bureau of Transportation, Maintenance Operations, is regularly in need of Mixed Bulk Concrete to meet its many maintenance obligations, including scheduled, routine, and emergency projects.
- 2. The most cost effective way to meet this need is to procure, on a long term contractual basis, the needed materials so there is an uninterruptible source of supply. This ensures the best value for the taxpayers of the City of Portland.
- 3. Invitation to Bid (ITB) No. 112344 was issued October 29, 2010, for Bulk Mixed Concrete and four bids were received. Pacific Rock Products, LLC, dba CEMEX was identified as the lowest responsible bidder. It has been determined that it is beneficial to the City to award a Price Agreement to the low bidder, Pacific Rock Products, LLC, dba CEMEX, for a not to exceed amount of \$2,850,000 for the 5-year contractual period. The City issued a Notice of Intent to Award a Contract to Pacific Rock Products, LLC, dba CEMEX, on December 2, 2010.
- 4. Pacific Rock Products, LLC, dba CEMEX, has a current City of Portland business license, is in compliance with the Equal Benefits Program, and their EEO Certification is current through November 30, 2012. The company is located in Vancouver, Washington, and is not an Oregon certified MWESB contractor.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to execute a Price Agreement with Pacific Rock Products, LLC, dba CEMEX, on behalf of the City for a not to exceed amount of \$570,000 per year, for a not to exceed amount of \$2,850,000 for the 5-year contract period.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver checks payable to the contractor for the Price Agreement and chargeable to the appropriate authorization and accounting center when demand is presented and approved by the proper authorities.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the materials and services described under this ordinance must be continued as quickly as possible in order to maintain current Portland Bureau of Transportation, Maintenance Operations. Therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
