ORDINANCE No.1 843 15

*Extend term of a franchise granted to McLeodUSA Telecommunications Services, Inc. to build and operate telecommunication facilities within City streets (Ordinance; amend Ordinance No. 175061)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. In November 2000, the City Council granted a ten year franchise to McLeodUSA Telecommunications Services, Inc., an Iowa corporation qualified to do business in Oregon, and to its successors and assigns, as approved by the City ("McLeodUSA"), to use the City streets to provide telecommunications services. Ordinance No. 175061. McLeodUSA filed an acceptance of the franchise grant in November, 2000.
- 2. Over the last 18 years the City Council has granted several telecommunications franchises, and many will expire soon. City staff has reviewed the terms and conditions of all of these franchises and is working with industry in an effort to standardize and modernize the terms and conditions of all franchises
- 3. The Portland Bureau of Transportation has undertaken to prepare substantial revisions to Portland City Code Title 17. Some of the planned amendments and updates may affect some of the standardized language of future franchises and renewals. City staff recommends, in the mutual interest of the parties, an extension of the franchise to allow the development of a new franchise.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Ordinance No. 175061 is hereby amended to extend the term of the franchise, continuously and without interruption, to December 31, 2011.
- b. All other terms and conditions of the franchise shall remain the same and unchanged.

- c. On or before the thirtieth (30th) day after this ordinance becomes effective, McLeodUSA Telecommunications Services, Inc. shall file in the Office of the Auditor of the City of Portland a written acceptance of this ordinance, executed by McLeodUSA Telecommunications Services, Inc. meeting the approval of the City Attorney. Any failure on the part of McLeodUSA Telecommunications Services, Inc. to file such written acceptance within such time shall be deemed an abandonment and rejection of this ordinance, and shall be construed to be an acceptance of all the terms contained in this ordinance.
- Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists because a lapse in McLeodUSA

 Telecommunications Services, Inc.'s authority to use the public right-of-way may
 potentially harm the public welfare by disrupting some services provided to the public
 by the permitee; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and
 after its passage by the Council.
