ORDINANCE No. 184386

*Amend contract with CMTS, Inc. to add Inspector Apprenticeship Program and increase compensation. (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 37903)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Ordinance 181678 authorized a contract between the City and CMTS, Inc. to supply construction management, inspection and project support personnel for Bureau of Environmental Services construction projects.
- 2. The Bureau of Environmental Services values diversity in the workforce and in the workforce of those with whom they contract, and seeks opportunities to increase diversity on construction work sites.
- 3. The Bureau of Environmental Services supports the creation of opportunities within our community for skills training where it complements the bureau's mission.
- 4. CMTS, Inc. and the Bureau of Environmental Services administered a successful Inspector Training Program during calendar years 2002-2004 and are interested in administering a revised Inspector Apprenticeship Program during calendar years 2011 and 2012.
- 5. The estimated cost is \$300,000. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, Cost Center ESEN000020.
- 6. M/W/ESB participation to date on this contract is \$3,231,755.00 or 26% of the total contract expenditures to date.

NOW, THEREFORE, the council directs:

- a. The Commissioner of Public Affairs is authorized to execute an amendment to Contract 37903 in the amount of \$300,000 for the purpose described in Section 1.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
- Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the Inspector Apprenticeship Program is scheduled to start by January 31, 2011 to maximize coordination with BES construction project schedules. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
