ORDINANCE NO.

* Authorize Intergovernmental Agreement with Portland Housing Bureau and Multnomah County, Health Department, Environmental Health Services Department to provide match for the Multnomah County HUD Healthy Homes Grant (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

SECTION 1. The Council finds that:

1. The Multnomah County Health Department was awarded a \$1,000,000 three year Healthy Homes grant from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development to assess and correct housing-related environmental health and safety hazards that may contribute to illness, injury, or adverse health outcomes for vulnerable populations such as children or elderly.
2. The Portland Housing Bureau (PHB) is committed to working collaboratively with the Multnomah County Health Department to address the connection between health and housing and its impacts low-income households.
3. PHB committed match resources in the amount of \$35,000 of CDBG annually to the Multnomah County Health Department Healthy Homes grant application to increase their ability to demonstrate leveraged resources.
4. Funding for these matching resources is included in PHB's FY 2010-11 approved budget in the amount of \$35,000 in CDBG funds.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council directs that:

- a. The Housing Commissioner and City Auditor are hereby authorized to execute agreements with the County in the amounts described above in accordance with the intergovernmental agreement attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the PHB operating fund budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.

SECTION 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay in funding would interrupt the ability of the Multnomah County Health Department to provide assistance and services to low-income households; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.



