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ORDINANCE No. 184422 As Amended

*Authorize the Bureau of Transportation to execute a Temporary Construction Easement with Multnomah County, a political subdivision of the State of Oregon, as part of the St Johns Pedestrian/Freight Project (Ordinance).

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The City of Portland Bureau of Transportation has initiated a project that implements elements of the St Johns Truck Strategy and the St Johns Lombard Plan to improve freight mobility and pedestrian safety within the St Johns town center. The project will improve turning radii and signal system efficiency along the designated freight route and provide curb extensions to improve pedestrian crossing safety.
- 2. Council previously authorized the acquisition of property rights for this project on January 13, 2010 (Ordinance 183457).
- 3. Subject to indemnification from the City, Multnomah County has agreed to convey a Temporary Construction Easement that is necessary for the completion of the project.
- 4. The Office of the City Attorney has reviewed this matter and recommends that the City approve the Temporary Construction Easement with the addition of indemnification language.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The City Engineer is hereby authorized to execute the Temporary Construction Easement with Multnomah County, in substantially the same form as the easement attached as Exhibit A.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay in property acquisition at this location will result in a construction delay of the St Johns Pedestrian/Freight Project and overall project completion; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
