ORDINANCE No. 184448

*Authorize a three-year contract with Michael J Gennaco OIR Group for the review of closed officer-involved shooting and in-custody death police investigations for a total not-to-exceed \$250,000 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. City Code authorizes the City Auditor's Independent Police Review (IPR) division to hire a qualified expert to review closed investigations pertaining to officer-involved shootings (OIS) and in-custody deaths (ICD) on an ongoing basis. Expert assessments are necessary to ensure that the Portland Police Bureau (PPB) is made aware of any emerging best practices related to deadly force, including police practices that increase officer safety and reduce the necessity of deadly force. The public is also well served by having an independent expert regularly demonstrate that PPB has provided a reasonable and appropriate level of evaluation of officer-involved shootings and in-custody deaths.
- 2. In November 2010, the above services were advertised through RFP No. 112384 and eight responsive proposals were received. The selection committee reviewed and scored these proposals in accordance with PCC 5.68 and selected the Michael J Gennaco OIR Group.
- 3. The City desires to enter into a PTE contract with Michael J Gennaco OIR Group with a not-to-exceed contract amount of \$250,000 over the three-year period of the contract.
- 4. Funding resides in the IPR account 521000 (cost object code AUCA000002) beginning FY 2010-11.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Chief Procurement Officer (CPO) is authorized to enter into a contract with Michael J Gennaco OIR Group for services in accordance with contract 30001866, attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The CPO is further authorized to execute amendments to this contract that do not exceed 25% of the original contract amount.
- c. The Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver checks payable to Michael J Gennaco OIR Group chargeable to the Office of the City Auditor, Independent Police Review division, when demand is presented and approved by the proper authorities.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay in funding would interrupt Michael J Gennaco OIR Group's ability to begin the reviews in a timely manner. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
