

ORDINANCE No. 184468

* Authorize a grant agreement with Portland Community College Foundation to administer \$5,000 in funds for the Youth Action Grants Program. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. On September 17, 2007, by Resolution No. 36537, City Council approved the Community Action Grant Funding Program recommended by the visionPDX project that Council adopted in 2005.
2. In March 2008, Vision into Action (VIA) Coalition began activities to implement the community vision articulated by visionPDX and selected a group of 12 community groups to receive up to \$10,000 in Community Action Grants. Recipients were chosen based on their ability to help advance the community vision, and projects were selected in each of the "Five Elements" identified through the visionPDX process: Built Portland, Economic Portland, Environmental Portland, Learning Portland, and Social Portland.
3. On April 30, 2008, by Ordinance No. 181766, and again on February 25, 2009, by Ordinance No. 182546, City Council authorized successive grant agreements with Portland Community College Foundation to administer \$10,000 in funds each year for the Youth Action Grants Program to provide up to \$1,000 per project for young people to launch community projects that address *Our Bill of Rights: Children and Youth* and Portland's community vision.
4. Portland Community College (PCC) Foundation supports a *Students4Giving: Inspiring Philanthropy* project that offers a cross-disciplinary and service-learning opportunity for students to learn about community needs, the grant-making process, and the role played by philanthropists and non-profit organizations in our communities.
5. The Bureau of Planning and Sustainability and Office of the Mayor have determined that a partnership with PCC Foundation and PCC lead instructors to administer the 2011 Youth Action Grants Program would again be an effective and efficient means to administer a third round of mini-grants to youth projects.
6. A total of \$5,000 in General Fund dollars is allocated in the Office of the Mayor, Multnomah Youth Commission FY 2010-2011 Adopted Budget for this program.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Office of the Mayor is authorized and directed to enter into a grant agreement substantially in conformance to the agreement attached as Exhibit A.

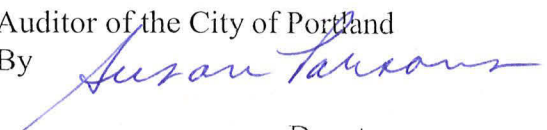
- b. The Office of the Mayor, in conjunction with the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability Youth Planning Program, is authorized to execute amendments to the grant agreement.

Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists because a delay in approving this grant may result in a delay in timely award of the Youth Action Grants Program during the Spring 2011, with selection occurring during spring term at PCC; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
