

ORDINANCE No. **184551**

* Amend Intergovernmental Agreement with Multnomah County to fund services that provide alternatives to prostitution (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 30000498)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The U.S. Department of Justice (USDOJ), Office of Justice Programs (OJP), Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA) is providing funding under the Recovery Act: Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Program Grant.
2. The allocations are as follows: City of Portland, \$1,728,375; Multnomah County, \$1,597,519.32; City of Fairview, \$13,822; City of Gresham, \$441,149; and the City of Troutdale, \$21,021.
3. A-condition of the grant required the City of Portland to serve as the fiscal agent and administrator for the disparate jurisdiction. The City executed the intergovernmental agreement to obligate agency roles and responsibilities.
4. The City wishes to amend the Intergovernmental Agreement to increase the compensation in an amount not to exceed \$270,851. Under the Amendment, the County will manage a contract with Lifeworks Inc., to provide professional treatment and support services to sex workers as a means to provide alternatives to prostitution.
5. Funding of \$270,851 will come from the City's portion of the grant award.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to amend Contract No. 30000498 substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A.

Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists because delay in proceeding with this amendment will unnecessarily deprive Multnomah County and the City of Portland of the mutual benefits of this amendment. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.


