ORDINANCE No. 184653

* Authorize \$42,000 for grant agreements of \$3,000 each divided between fourteen civic participation organizations funded by the Office of Neighborhood Involvement for technical assistance for financial and nonprofit management consultation services. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. These fourteen civic engagement organizations are critical partners working with ONI to implement *The Five-Year Plan to Strengthen Community Involvement in Portland*, (adopted by City Council on February 27, 2008), which includes concrete actions steps organized around three interdependent goals:
 - Increase the number and diversity of people involved in their communities
 - Strengthen community capacity
 - Increase community impact on public decisions
- 2. This grant agreement provides technical assistance for financial and non-profit management professional consultation services through June 30, 2012. The goal is to ensure the financial administration policies and practices for these organizations are modeled on current best practices. The objective will be to train their volunteer leadership in the basic rules of financial responsibilities as board members of nonprofit organizations and to provide staff leadership professional review of their fiscal policies and practices.
- 3. The Office of Management and Finance has encouraged ONI to work with its nonprofit partner organizations to review and develop their financial administration policies and practices.
- 4. ONI requested and was granted a transfer of funds approved in the spring BuMP to be evenly divided among these organizations for this purpose. A total of \$42,000 is to be evenly divided into \$3,000 grants for each of the fourteen organizations with FY 2010-11 funds in ONI's budget. The term of this grant is one year through June 30, 2012.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The Director of the Office of Neighborhood Involvement and the City Auditor are authorized to execute grant agreements on behalf of the City to the fourteen organizations listed below in a form substantially in accordance with Exhibit 1 in the amounts below:
