## ORDINANCE No. 184682

\* Accept a grant in the amount of \$176,000 and appropriate \$12,705 for Fiscal Year 2010-11 from the Oregon Department of Justice and the Oregon High Intensity Drug Trafficking Areas program for Portland Interdiction Team efforts (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Police Bureau applied to the Oregon Department of Justice (ODOJ), Oregon High Intensity Drug Trafficking Areas (HIDTA) program for a grant for funding to support two bureau programs. The Drugs and Vice Division HIDTA Interdiction Team (HIT) provides efforts in disrupting and dismantling drug trafficking organizations in Multnomah, Washington and Clackamas Counties by employing a multi-agency approach to significantly impact drug availability in the area. The Metro Gang Task Force (MGTF) Initiative provides the Bureau with the means to assist in the investigation of violent street gang members who are involved in the distribution of controlled substances in the Portland area:
- 2. The Oregon Department of Justice was awarded \$1,247,400 by the Office of National Drug Control Policy's High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (HIDTA) Program to support initiatives designed to implement the strategy proposed by the Executive Board of the Oregon HIDTA Program and approved by the Office of National Drug Control Policy (ONDCP) for the grant period January 1, 2011, through December 31, 2012;
- 3. The Oregon HIDTA program has notified the City of Portland that it will award a grant for the HIDTA Initiatives to the Police Bureau in the amount of \$176,000;
- 4. The ODOJ will reimburse the City a maximum of \$176,000 for investigative overtime and program expenses; and
- 5. No match is required by this grant.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from the Oregon Department of Justice in the amount of \$176,000 and to execute an intergovernmental agreement with the State of Oregon acting by and through its Department of State Police.
- b. The FY 2010-11 budget is hereby amended as follows:

  Fund 217001

Business Area – PL00 Bureau Program Expenses – \$12,705

- c. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.
- d. The Chief of the Police Bureau of the City of Portland is authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland any subsequent modifications by ODOJ HIDTA for the HIDTA grant, award number G110R0002A, provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
