# ORDINANCE No. 184743

\*Amend contract with Environmental Systems Research Institute, Inc. for geographical information system software maintenance and technical support through June 30, 2014 and increase by \$817,000 (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 40983)

### The City of Portland ordains:

#### Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. In 1999, the Information Technology Executive Committee (ITEC) determined the Environmental Systems Research Institute Inc. (ESRI) software product to be the right software system for the City's enterprise geographic information systems (GIS). Ordinance No. 173164 approved the move to a standard GIS environment and authorized Contract No. C32266 with ESRI to provide an enterprise GIS software license agreement.
- 2. The City implemented an extensive enterprise GIS, utilizing the ESRI product suite, throughout the City.
- 3. In 2006, it was determined that it would be extremely cost prohibitive to migrate to an alternate software solution given the usage and extent of reliance on the ESRI software throughout the City. As a result, Council approved Ordinance No. 179884, to execute Contract No. C40983 for an initial three year period to provide an enterprise license agreement for cost effective licensing of the ESRI products.
- 4. In 2009, Ordinance No. 182739 authorized an amendment to City Contract No. C40983 for an additional three years from July 1, 2008 to June 30, 2011 at a cost of \$727,000. Amendment No. 1 also allowed for up to four additional one year options, taken in single or multiple year increments.
- 5. This Ordinance authorizes an amendment to City Contract No. C40983 for an additional three years, from July 1, 2011 to June 30, 2014 at a cost of \$817,000.

#### NOW THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The City's Chief Procurement Officer is hereby authorized to execute an amendment to City Contract No. C40983, extending the current expiration date to June 30, 2014, and adding \$817,000 in a form substantially in conformance with the amendment attached as Exhibit A, provided the amendment has been approved as to form by the City Attorney.
