## ORDINANCE No. 184808

Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with Portland State University in an amount not to exceed \$50,000 to conduct sustainability-related research and analysis services on the City's Solid Waste Management and Recycling programs. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Both the State of Oregon and the City of Portland have adopted aggressive waste reduction goals that rely on increasing recycling for all sectors.
- 2. The City wants to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) with State of Oregon Board of Education acting through Portland State University (PSU) to conduct waste sorts, data gathering, sampling, testing and other studies as needed so as to make recommendations as to how best to expand and improve the City's garbage and recycling programs.
- 3. PSU Center for Urban Studies in the College of Urban and Public Affairs established the Community Environmental Services (CES) program in 1989 to provide research, technical assistance, data collection and educational outreach services in the areas of solid waste, recycling, transportation and program evaluation.
- 4. Under this agreement, CES will conduct studies according to Task Orders that specify a scope of work, deliverables and compensation.
- 5. The establishment of a not-to-exceed IGA based upon estimated amounts of work without a specific City commitment to purchase any given amount of service is in the best interests of the City to accomplish these tasks within the time required. An on-call agreement for these services facilitates long-term planning, increases control, and provides for an uninterrupted supply of needed services.
- 6. Funds have been appropriated in the FY 2011-12 budget for the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability, Solid Waste Management Fund, to cost center PNSD000006.

## NOW THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The Director of the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability is authorized to enter into an agreement with Portland State University in a form substantially in conformance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A.

b. The Director of the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability is authorized to execute subsequent amendments that do not increase the City's performance obligations or financial risk.
