

ORDINANCE No. 184819

Amend contract with CMTS, Inc. to increase compensation for temporary construction management, inspection and project support for Combined Sewer Overflow Program (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 37903)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Ordinance No. 181678 authorized Contract No. 37903 with CMTS, Inc. to supply construction management, inspection and project support personnel for Bureau of Environmental Services construction projects through December 31, 2012.
2. An increase in the contract not-to-exceed limit is necessary for continued temporary construction management, inspection and project support personnel for projects under construction and during start-up and close-out for the Combined Sewer Overflow Program.
3. The established cost is \$2,500,000. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY2012 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, Cost Center ESEN000020.

NOW, THEREFORE, the council directs:

- a. The Commissioner of Public Affairs is authorized to execute an amendment with CMTS LLC for the purpose described in Section 1, in the amount of \$2,500,000.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.

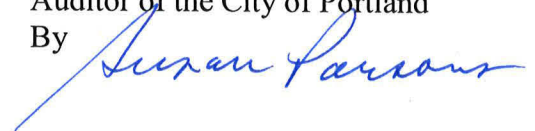
