

ORDINANCE No. 184824

*Authorize a competitive invitation to bid for storage area network hardware, software and services (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bureau of Technology Services (BTS) requires replacement of the City of Portland's (City) Storage Area Network (SAN) infrastructure, as components reach the end of their service life, over the next three to five years. Additionally, BTS requires the ability to expand the SAN infrastructure to meet the City's growing electronic storage needs.
2. BTS requires the ability to procure SAN hardware and software compatible with the existing SAN infrastructure, maintenance and support services for current and new SAN infrastructure, and staff training on current and new SAN hardware and software.
3. Specification of exact hardware and software required over the next five years is not possible due to the rapid change in technology and unknown expansion needs of City bureaus.
4. A brand name specification of Hitachi Data Systems (HDS) has been authorized in order to ensure compatibility with existing HDS SAN equipment in which the City has made a substantial capital investment over the past six years.
5. The most cost effective way to meet these needs is to procure, on a long term contractual basis, the needed equipment and materials via a price agreement so as to continue an uninterrupted source of supply and efficient operation. This source of supply, based on a competitive solicitation, will ensure the best value for City taxpayers.
6. The estimated cost for replacement, growth and support services over the next five years is \$8,000,000.
7. BTS seeks the Council authorization for Procurement Services to issue an Invitation to Bid (ITB) resulting in a general price agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to facilitate the use of the competitive solicitation process in order to obtain the most responsible and responsive Offeror providing a general price agreement for Hitachi Data Systems SAN hardware, software and services.
- b. Upon Council acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's Report, Procurement Services

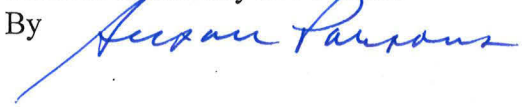
is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in proceeding with the purchase will unnecessarily put the City at risk from continued operations on SAN system that has reached the end of its service life; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
