## ORDINANCE No. 184848

\* Accept a grant in the amount of \$199,883 and appropriate \$151,568 for FY 2011-12 from the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance for the FY11 Intellectual Property Crime Enforcement Program (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Police Bureau applied to the U.S. Department of Justice (USDOJ), Office of Justice Programs (OJP), Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA) for FY11 Intellectual Property Crime Enforcement Program grant on February 23, 2011; and
- 2. The USDOJ OJP has notified the City of Portland that it will award a grant for the FY11 Intellectual Property Crime Enforcement Program to the Police Bureau in the amount of \$199,883; and
- 3. The USDOJ will reimburse the City a maximum of \$199,883 for grant program expenses incurred by the Police Bureau; and
- 4. No match is required for this grant; and
- 5. The grant period is October 1, 2011, through September 30, 2012.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from the U.S. Department of Justice for the FY11 Intellectual Property Crime Enforcement Program in the amount of \$199,883 and to execute an future intergovernmental agreement with Multnomah County for 0.5 FTE Deputy District Attorney.
- b. The FY 2011-2012 budget is hereby amended as follows:

## **GRANTS FUND**

Fund - 217

Business Area - PL00

Bureau Program Expenses - \$151,568

c. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

d. The Chief of the Police Bureau of the City of Portland is authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland any subsequent modifications by the U.S. Department of Justice for the FY11 Intellectual Property Crime Enforcement Program, #2011-BE-BX-0003, provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
