ORDINANCE NO. 184866

* Authorize application to the Federal Emergency Management Agency for a grant in the amount of \$518,400 for the purchase of individual facepieces for firefighter's self-contained breathing apparatus (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Department of Homeland Security (DHS) through its Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) has offered the Assistance to Firefighters Fire Grant Program since 2001. The grant funds a variety of programs to enhance public and firefighter safety.
- 2. The self-contained breathing apparatus (SCBA) devices, paired with firefighting facepieces are worn by firefighters to provide breathable air in atmospheres that pose immediate danger to life and health, including high heat, low oxygen, and highly contaminated environments.
- 3. Currently, Portland Fire & Rescue (PF&R) provides only enough facepieces to be paired with the SCBA dedicated to the on-duty firefighter seat on each apparatus, therefore, requiring that each facepiece be shared amongst whomever is working in that assignment. Firefighters lack individually assigned facepieces.
- 4. Shared facepieces have been linked to cross-contamination of airborne pathogens, increasing the risks for firefighters of contracting infectious diseases.
- 5. PF&R has developed a grant proposal to fund facepieces that will be individually issued to active firefighters.
- 6. FEMA requires a twenty (20) percent local match.
- 7. Local match in the amount of \$129,600 will be provided by funds from the FY 2012 operations budget of PF&R.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to make application to FEMA for a grant in the amount of \$518,400.
- b. The Mayor is authorized to provide such information and assurances as are required for the grant period.
- c. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the grant application must be submitted by September 16, 2011. Therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
