## **ORDINANCE No.** 184878

\*Authorize Intergovernmental Agreement with Metro for study of transportation and park-related projects at Washington Park. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The City of Portland, through its Portland Parks & Recreation (PP&R), and Metro both own property in Washington Park.
- 2. PP&R and Metro desire to enter into an intergovernmental agreement to define how the two entities will work together to complete studies of future transportation and park-related projects in Washington Park.

NOW, THEREFORE, The Council Directs:

a. The Director of Parks is authorized to execute an Intergovernmental Agreement with Metro. The License Agreement will be substantially similar to the attached and approved as to form by the City Attorney.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to avoid delay of the studies that will lead to transportation and park-related improvements at Washington Park; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
