

# ORDINANCE No. 184881

\* Authorize contract with Patton Boggs LLP for representation in Washington, DC on matters pertaining to the relationship between the City and the federal government (Ordinance)

The City of Portland Ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The City required the services of a Contractor working in Washington DC to advise the City and perform other services for the City in connection with the activities of the federal government.
2. Patton Boggs LLP was chosen by the City as its choice for the Contract award, based on the criteria set forth in the bidding process.
3. Council has appropriated funds for such services in the FY 2011-12 Budget.
4. The City is authorizing \$16,500 per month compensation for this Contract as outlined in Exhibit A, attached to this Ordinance.
5. The City authorizes \$198,000 per year for compensation to Patton Boggs LLP for federal representation services.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That the Mayor and the City Auditor are authorized to execute an agreement on behalf of the City with Patton Boggs LLP, substantially the same as attached to this Ordinance as Exhibit A, effective September 1, 2011.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay in execution of this contract would interrupt federal representation of the City's interests; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
