## ORDINANCE No. 184935

\*Amend grant agreement with U.S. Department of Energy for Solar America Initiative: Solar City Strategic Partnerships to accept \$15,270 to fund activities to further the market expansion of solar energy within the City (Ordinance; amend Grant Agreement SD000005)

The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds

- 1. In 2007, with the passage of Ordinance 181375, Bureau of Planning and Sustainability, formerly the Office of Sustainable Development, accepted funds from the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) for \$200,000 under the "Solar America Initiative: Solar City Strategic Partnerships Market Transformation" program.
- 2. DOE has notified the City of Portland that it will award up to \$20,000 in additional funds to the original amount of \$200,000 in order for Portland to continue to participate in collaborative DOE meetings and report regularly on installation metrics. The Bureau of Planning and Sustainability has been awarded an additional \$15,270.
- 3. Since 1990, with the passage of Ordinance 162975, the City has had a stated policy to "support environmentally acceptable, sustainable energy sources, especially renewable resources such as solar."
- 4. The City's Bureau of Planning and Sustainability will administer these funds in order to implement the project.
- 5. Additional local match in the amount of \$15,368 will be provided in the form of salary, benefits, and materials and services in the FY 2011-12 budget of the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability.

## NOW THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept and sign on behalf of the City of Portland a grant extension from the United States Department of Energy for the "Solar America Initiative: Solar City Strategic Partnerships" for an additional amount of \$15,270 in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The FY 2011/2012 budget is hereby amended as follows:

**GRANTS FUND** 

Fund 217

Business Area - PN00

Bureau Program Expenses— \$15,270

Matching funds were included in the FY 2011/12 budget.

- c. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.
- d. The Director of the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability of the City of Portland is authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland any subsequent modifications by DOE for Grant SD000005, award number GO17064, provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant. Therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
