ORDINANCE NO. 8 184954

*Amend contract with Columbia Analytical Services, Inc. to increase compensation for laboratory services (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 30000649)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Water Bureau entered into a contract with Columbia Analytical Services, Inc. to provide on-call laboratory services to perform water quality analysis that Water Bureau laboratory staff does not have the availability, expertise, or necessary equipment to perform.
- 2. The Water Bureau is preparing to release a Request for Proposal for a new on-call laboratory services contract. However the existing contract has been exhausted due to larger than anticipated expenditures from PWB laboratory overflow, the Ultra Violet Pilot Project, Long Term 2 Enhanced Surface Water Treatment Rule (LT2) related (non-Cryptosporidium) sampling, and most recently, the Dollar Lake Fire water quality sampling.
- 3. The purpose of this ordinance is to amend the contract with Columbia Analytical Services, Inc. to allow for analysis of regulatory water quality samples and availability for critical sampling until the Water Bureau can enter into a new laboratory services contract.
- 4. The contract will be amended to increase the budget by \$30,000. The new contract total will be \$155,000. Funding is available in the FY 2011-12 Budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That the Commissioner-in-Charge and Auditor are authorized to execute on behalf of the City an amendment to Contract No. 30000649 with Columbia Analytical Services, Inc. as outlined in a form substantially in accordance with the contract amendment attached as Exhibit A, at a cost not to exceed \$30,000.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver checks chargeable to the Water Fund when demand is presented and approved by the proper authorities.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in funding would prevent the Water Bureau from performing the required regulatory water quality analysis; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
