

ORDINANCE No. 185031

*Accept a grant in the amount of \$148,000 from Oregon Department of Transportation for the purchase and installation of traffic signal priority equipment at intersections throughout the City (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Bureau of Transportation, in partnership with TriMet, applied to ODOT for a grant in the amount of \$4,000,770 for the purchase and installation of traffic signal priority equipment on October 13, 1999; and
2. On June 21, 2000, the City of Portland accepted the grant award for the purchase and installation of traffic signal priority equipment from ODOT in the amount of \$2,800,770; as a result, bus priority devices and improved traffic signal controllers were installed at nearly 350 signalized intersections in the City.
3. There is \$148,000 in Federal TEA-21 transportation funds remaining that the Bureau of Transportation would like to utilize to complete the project; as a result, Opticom devices and improved signal controllers would be installed at an additional 30 signalized intersections throughout the City of Portland.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from ODOT for the purchase and installation of traffic signal priority equipment in the amount of \$148,000 and/or Auditor to execute an Intergovernmental Agreement in substantially the form of the attached exhibit for this purpose.
- b. The FY 2011/2012 budget is hereby amended as follows

Bureau Program Expenses - \$148,000

- c. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.


